The Head of the Department (HOD) of the Department of Philosophy and the Coordinator, IQAC of DMM shall coordinate the programme in direct liaison with the Counsellor, the students and the college authorities.

Legal Relationship :

This MoU shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote the overall qualities of the students. Nothing in this MoU shall create any legal relationship between the parties.

Financial Arrangement :

Based on the numbers of counselling sessions, DMM shall offer an honorarium which will be mutually agreeable to both the parties.

Confidentiality :

Both parties acknowledge that by virtue of entering into this agreement they may, at times, have access to the confidential information regarding each other's operation. Both agree that they shall not disclose confidential information without consent of the other party unless the disclosure is authorised by any other agreement.

Commencement, Renewal and Termination :

This MoU shall be effective from 02-03- 2022 and shall remain in force for a period of 2 (two) years with the provision of extension at the end two years, subject to acceptance of both the parties.

Both parties after completion of two years will be at the liberty review, renew, extend or terminate the same.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on 27th day of May, 2023, in Digboi, Tinsukia, Assam.

BETWEEN

Girijananda Chowdhury University, Hathkhowapara, Azara, Guwahati, Assam 781017, a private university established in accordance with the provisions of the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007, (Assam Legislative Act XLVII (47) of 2022) and approved by the UGC; through the Vice-Chancellor/Registrar, of the One Part.

AND

Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya, situated at Digboi-Pengeri Rd, Dist.-Tinsukia, Assam, Pin- 786171, established in 1981, is a women's general degree college affiliated with Dibrugarh University under 12(B) w.e.f. 01.01.1993, and provincialized in 2005 under the Assam Govt. College Provincialization Act, 2005 (Assam Act, No XLVI of 2005), through the Principal, of the Other Part.

WHEREAS the Girijananda Chowdhury University (hereinafter referred to as GCU) is a reputed University in India providing higher education in most of the branches of knowledge, besides excelling in research in various disciplines in Science, Technology and Humanities, Management and Commerce Streams, in addition to being a pioneer institution in innovating new ideas in education.

AND WHEREAS Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya (hereinafter referred to as Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya) is an excellent institution of higher learning. The institution, since its inception, has been promoting and expediting the education of women and has been providing qualitative higher education in the region through various parts of life, viz., cultural activities, sports, and social harmonization among diverse tribes, cast and creed act.

WHEREAS the Girijananda Chowdhury University and Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya are willing to cooperate in the promotion of teaching, research, and innovation, desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for the purpose of fulfilling their objectives in a better way.

1. SCOPE OF COOPERATION:

- 1.1 The activities to be carried out under this cooperation shall include:
- exchange of students
 - the exchange of teaching and research scholars
 - joint scientific research
 - the exchange of scientific papers and publications
 - the exchange of academic information and publications
 - promotion of participation of the faculty members in the courses, conferences, seminars, etc.
 - joint organizations of conferences, seminars, workshops, etc.
 - joint publications of academic work

The organizations will also coordinate activities such as:

- joint academic programs leading to award of certificate, diploma and degree by Girijananda Chowdhury University
 - collaborative cultural programs
 - collaborative language programs
 - student exchange programs
 - faculty exchanges
 - joint research projects and educational programs
 - course and curriculum sharing and development
 - utilize library resources of both the institutions
 - undertake student internships based on academic requirements
 - organizing seminars/conferences/workshops/lectures etc.
- 1.2 Both the Institutions will endeavor to assist each other in the development of their educational services.
- 1.3 Both the Institutions will attempt to maintain parity with personal exchange arrangements over the period of this MOU.
- 1.4 Whilst the purpose of this MOU is to outline an academic and management framework between the Institutions, they do not intend to be legally bound to each other, and this MOU does not impose any legal obligation on either party.

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- 1.5 This MOU shall not be assignable by either University, in whole, or in part, without prior written consent of the other University.
- 1.6 The undertaking of each activity to be carried out under this MOU will be subject to the availability of funds.

2. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHT:

- 2.1 Unless otherwise agreed to, all rights and title to Intellectual Property, whether or not patentable, conceived and reduced to practice, in the performance of the activities under this MOU, exclusively by any two universities/organizations shall be owned by that university/organization.
- 2.2 All rights and title to Intellectual Property whether or not patentable, conceived and reduced to practice jointly by employees of both universities/organizations shall be jointly owned. Neither university/organization shall use or license to any third party such jointly owned intellectual property for any purpose, whatsoever, without prior written consent of the other university/organization.

3. COORDINATION COMMITTEE:

- 3.1 There will be a Co-ordination Committee for effective execution of the activities to be carried out under this MOU and for reviewing their progress. The composition of this Committee will be as follows:
- 3.2 A Senior Faculty member of Girijananda Chowdhury University, nominated by the Vice-Chancellor, GCU, will be Coordinator of the activity.
- 3.3 One Joint Coordinator nominated by the Vice-Chancellor of Girijananda Chowdhury University.
- 3.4 One member nominated by the Vice-Chancellor of the Girijananda Chowdhury University.
- 3.5 The Committee shall submit a written report of the progress of the activities to be carried out under this MOU to each Party, annually, together with any suggestions for improvements.
- 3.6 A similar committee shall be formed by the other university/organization.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY:

The parties agree that the ownership of and any other rights relating to intellectual property arising from or in connection with any program or activity under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be determined on a case-by-case basis, and

shall therefore be specified and agreed for each such program or activity in a separate written agreement between the parties.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF THE MOU:

This MOU shall be effective from the date it is signed by the parties hereto. The duration of the MOU will be initially for a period of 03 (three) years from the effective date, unless or otherwise terminated earlier, as per Clause 6.

6. AMENDMENT TO MOU:

No amendment to this MOU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing jointly by the parties hereto or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment to this MOU.

7. TERMINATION OF MOU:

7.1 The MOU can be terminated by either party giving the other party, a prior written notice of not less than ninety days of its intention to do so, but without dishonoring any commitment entered into prior to the date of termination notice.

7.2 This MOU shall also stand terminated for any reason such as legal processes, Acts of the State or similar such exigencies beyond the normal control of the party concerned and which disabled any of the parties hereto from functioning further.

7.3 Despite termination, the parties shall abide by the usual professional ethics and normal code of conduct to maintain the confidentiality of the information and intellectual property rights.

8. DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

Any dispute arising under the terms and conditions of this MOU shall be referred to a competent independent Arbitrator as agreed to by both the Institutions.

9. Force Majeure:

For the purpose of this MOU, the expression Force Majeure shall mean any clause affecting the performance of a party of its obligation arising from the acts, events, omissions, happenings, or non-happenings, beyond its reasonable control including (but without limiting the generality thereof), government regulations, fire, flood, earthquakes, strikes, or any other disaster or an industrial dispute, affecting a third party for which a substitute third party is not reasonably available. Any act, event,

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omission, happening, or non-happening will be considered Force Majeure, if it is not attributed to willful act, neglect, or failure to take reasonable precautions of the affected party. Neither party shall whatsoever, including but not limited to any damage or abetment of charges whatever directly or indirectly caused to or incurred by the other party by reason of any failure or delaying the performances of its obligation hereunder which is due Force Majeure. Notwithstanding the foregoing, each party shall use all reasonable endeavors to continue to perform or resume the performance of such obligations hereunder for the duration of such Force Majeure event.

- USTM and Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya will jointly organize Seminars, Workshops, Conferences, Symposiums & Competitions from time to time.

- f) **Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya** shall facilitate the students of USTM for Internship programmes/ project works/exposure trips/placement from time to time.
- g) Apart from the aforesaid linkage USTM and **Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya** shall collaborate to organize extension and outreach activities like socio economic & welfare initiatives for neighboring & rural communities.
- h) USTM and **Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya** will jointly associate for academic collaboration in ICT, Counseling, Training etc. for teachers, staff and students from time to time.
- i) USTM and **Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya** will jointly organize awareness campaigns, rallies, streetplays etc. on relevant and burning issues, celebrate important occasions and appreciate good works by offering felicitation to the performers from time to time.
- j) USTM and **Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya** will extend support to the people in distress during any natural calamity of the region, e.g. flood, earthquake, landslides etc.
- k) USTM and **Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya** will also work for peace, brotherhood, national integrity and communal harmony.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of understanding between Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya (institution) henceforth called the 'host institution' and Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University henceforth called the "University" in respect of organizational responsibilities to act as Study Centre is signed today the 7th day of June (month) 2023.

1. The host institution shall :

- i) admit students (learners) on behalf of the University and receive the admission fee and other fee fixed by the University in the form of bank draft (in case of online admission, it is not required) only for onward transmission to the University and charge no other fee from the learners;
- ii) provide at least 1 (one) room of about 400 sq. ft. for exclusive use of the Study Centre of KKHSOU;
- iii) make halls / rooms available to the Study Centre to be used for holding contact classes and examinations, if required.
- iv) have no right to claim as examination centre.
- v) hold at least 12 Counselling Sessions of one-hour duration for a 4-credit course. Counselling Session may be arranged preferably on Sundays/ holidays.
- vi) extend library facilities to the learners of KKHSOU;
- vii) provide laboratory and Computer facilities to the learners of KKHSOU for specialized programmes requiring institutional infrastructure facilities on mutually agreed terms;
- viii) have phone, fax / e-mail facilities;
- ix) have CC camera in rooms in case the Centre is entrusted with the responsibility of conducting a particular examination of the University
- x) ensure security of the University properties provided to the Study Centre by the University;
- xi) not use the equipments and other properties received from the University for any other purpose without written permission from the University;
- xii) convey to the learners various information and instructions issued by the University from time to time;
- xiii) display prominently a signboard of KKHSOU Study Centre with the emblem of the University as in reverse page superscribed on it ;
- xiv) provide space for Notice Board / Wall Magazine for the learners of the Centre
- xv) allow the authorized officer of the University to inspect the functioning of the Study Centre as and when necessary;
- xvi) give 6 (six) month's notice to the University in the event of its unilateral decision to discontinue as Study Centre and take full responsibility of the enrolled learner's future on its failure to do so.
- xvii) Compliances to the norms of Study Centres as may be laid down by Distance Education Bureau of University Grants Commission from time to time.

2. The University shall :

- i) provide self learning materials (SLM) at the time of admission for distribution among the learners;
- ii) at the initial stage refund 50 % of the course fee collected from the learners and 20 % of the sale proceeds of application forms and prospectus to the Study Centre for its maintenance including counseling classes;
- iii) provide one computer with a printer to those Study Centres which enroll more than 150 learners and one TV set with DVD players to those Study Centres enrolling more than 200 learners in order to facilitate its better functioning depending upon the availability of fund, however, the ownership of these equipments will rest with the University
- iv) defray traveling expenses to the head of the host institution/project coordinator/other faculty members whenever invited/deputed by the University to attend seminar/workshop etc. ;
- v) give notice to the host institution in case of any unilateral decision to discontinue the study centre on issues of mismanagement & financial irregularities and take full responsibility of the learners of the centre.

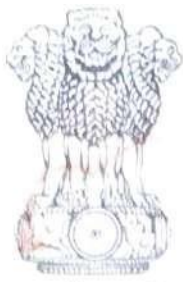





1. To accommodate students from Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya (80+) at Lila Bhawan Hostel.


Terms and conditions:

7. To charge admission and boarding fees as per the application submitted to the Principal of the College.



Tenure, Administration, Renewal and Termination:
