3. Problem Solving Learning

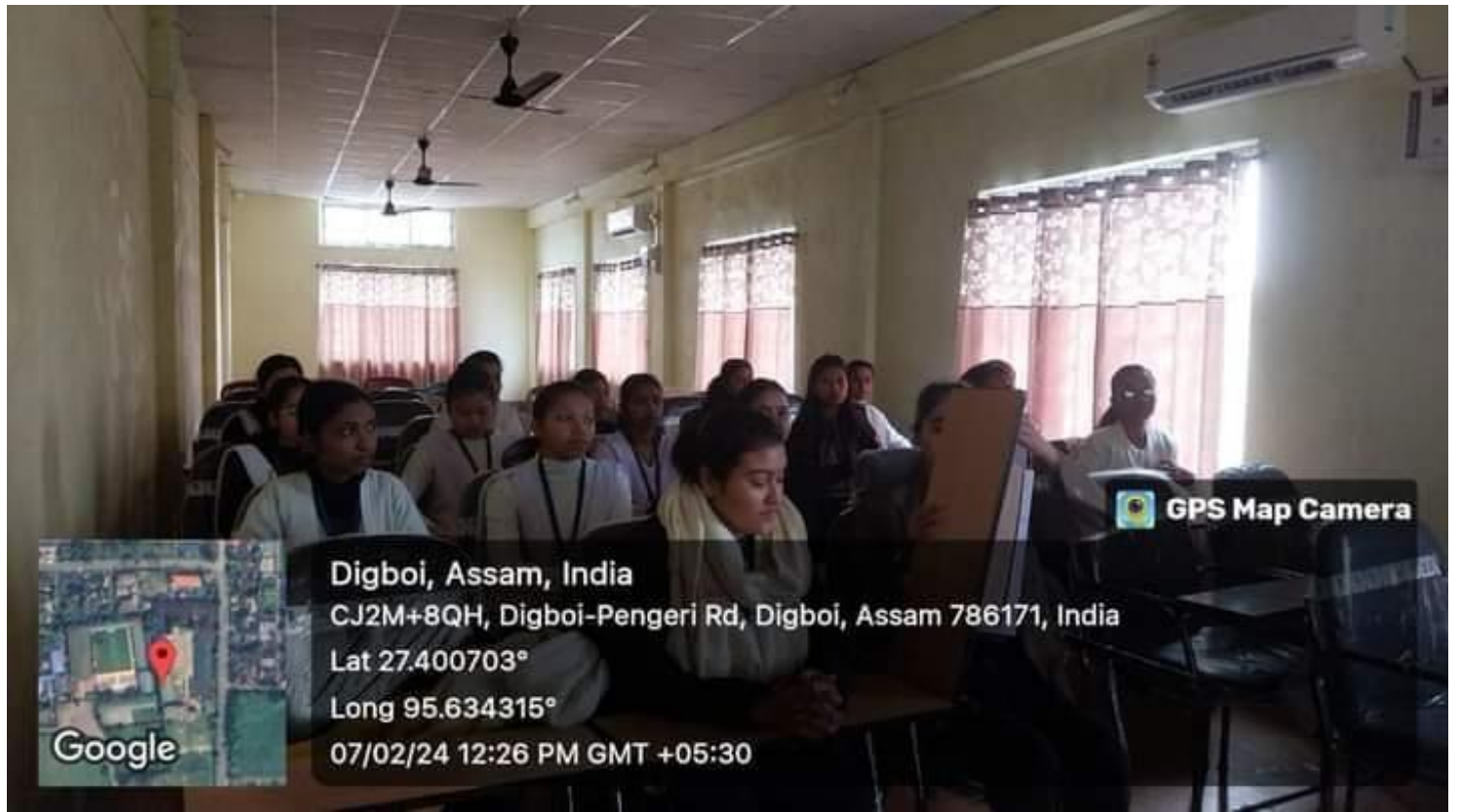
