1. Weaving (2023-2024)

Report on Add-on Course in Weaving

Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya (DMM) has been taking forward its mission of empowering women by offering various skill-based courses, including an Add-on Course on Weaving. This course, introduced in 2024, was aimed at teaching the traditional craft of weaving, which holds cultural significance in Assam. The course provided both theoretical knowledge and practical experience, helping students preserve the rich heritage of weaving while promoting entrepreneurship. The Weaving Add-on course was conducted over a period of eight weeks, beginning in August 2024. With a total of 50 hours of training, the course introduced students to the basics of weaving, from handling the loom to creating intricate designs on textiles. Weaving, being a key part of Assamese culture, was chosen as a course to not only impart a valuable skill but also promote traditional arts and self-reliance among students. The objectives of the course were to teach the art of traditional handloom weaving to the students, To provide practical skills that could lead to employment or entrepreneurial ventures, - To preserve and promote local heritage through the craft of weaving, To encourage women to explore career opportunities in the handloom and textile industry. The practical aspect of the course was intensive, with students spending several hours each week on the looms. Under the guidance of skilled instructors, students learned to weave simple fabric pieces and gradually progressed to more complex designs. Special attention was given to traditional Assamese patterns, such as those used in weaving Mekhela Chador, the traditional attire of Assamese women. The success of the Weaving Add-on Course has prompted Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya to consider offering advanced levels of the course and expanding its vocational programs to other traditional arts and crafts.




2. Beautician (2023-2024)

Report on Add-On Course in Beautician

Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya (DMM) launched an Add-on Course on Beautician Training in 2024 to equip its students with practical skills in the beauty and personal care industry. The course aimed to provide hands-on training and theoretical knowledge on various beauty treatments and techniques, promoting self-employment and entrepreneurial opportunities for women. The Beautician Add-on course ran for six months, from August 2023 to January2024, with a total of 6 months. The course was open to students from all streams, designed to teach them the fundamentals of beauty care, grooming, makeup, and skin treatments. With the increasing demand for beauty professionals in the market, the course focused on equipping participants with industry-relevant skills. The objectives of the course were to provide students with the knowledge of basic and advanced beauty treatments, To offer hands-on training in makeup, hair styling, and skincare, To create opportunities for women to enter the beauty and wellness industry, To inspire entrepreneurship and self-reliance through skill-based education. The course included regular hands-on practice where students worked in groups and practiced on each other. They were encouraged to experiment with different makeup looks, try new hairstyles, and perform facials under the guidance of instructors. The practical sessions provided a space for students to develop their skills and build confidence in delivering beauty services.

3. Baking (2023-2024) Report

Report on Add-on Course in Baking

Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya organized an Add-on Course on Baking to enhance practical skills among its students and promote self-employment opportunities. The Add-on course ran for a period of six months, starting in August 2023 and concluding in January2024. It included both theoretical and practical sessions, spread over 6 months. The course content was designed to cater to beginners while also providing room for students to experiment with advanced baking techniques. The objectives of the course were to provide a platform for students to learn the basics of baking, to introduce students to modern baking equipment and techniques and to encourage entrepreneurship by helping students explore the commercial aspects of baking. By the end of the course, students were able to: Prepare a variety of baked goods independently, use modern baking equipment effectively, develop creativity in baking and decorating and understand the fundamentals of starting a small-scale baking business. The course received overwhelmingly positive feedback from participants. Many students expressed that the course boosted their confidence in baking and sparked interest in exploring it as a career option. The administration at Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya has plans to continue such vocational add-on courses in the future to promote skill development and entrepreneurship among its students.


