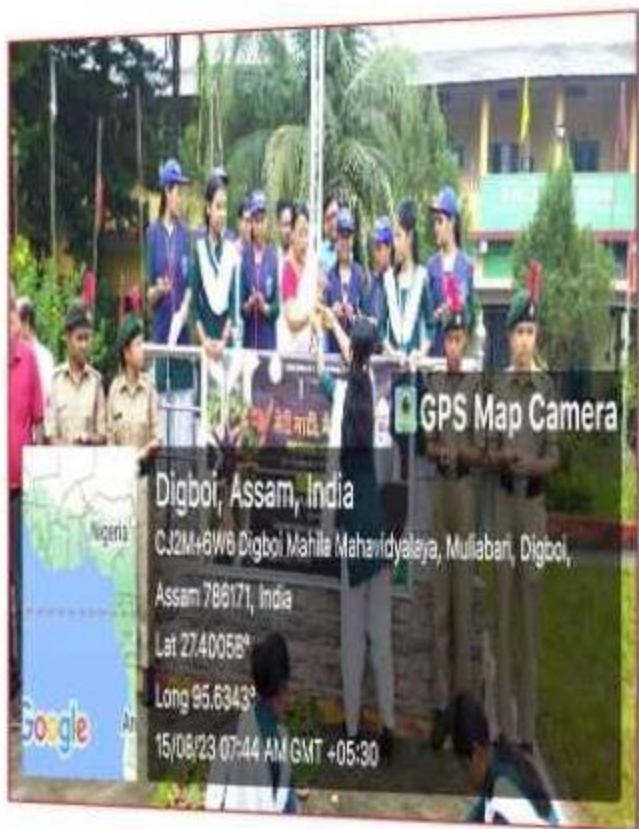

1) Awareness campaigns:

Free Health Check-up Camp

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As part of institutional social responsibility, the college is committed to extension services to its vicinity, outskirts and distant places. Hence, the college has adopted 5 villages located in its vicinity and on the outskirts. In the higher education scenario, the institutes of higher education are expected to involve in services at the ground level through adoption of villages. Being one of the frontline colleges of Assam, Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya has involved itself in this noble task for years. The college tries its best to deliver its resources in its adopted villages in recent times. It is determined to bring about transformations in the adopted villages as far as possible

3. Brief Introduction of the Adopted Villages: **Dhekiajan Forest Village No 1**, is a forest village, with a total geographical area of 216.71 hectares and is situated 30km away from sub-district headquarter Margherita (tehsildar office) and 50km away from district headquarter Tinsukia. Dhekiajan village has a total population of 1,186 people, out of which male population is 595 while female population is 591. Literacy rate of Dhekiajan forest village no 1 is 66.53% out of which 74.62% males and 58.38% females are literate. There are about 222 houses in Dhekiajan forest village.

Bhim Pathar Village is located in Margherita subdivision of Tinsukia district in Assam, India. It is situated 10km away from sub-district headquarter Margherita (tehsildar office) and 43km away from district headquarter Tinsukia. The total geographical area of village is 250.44 hectares. Bhimpathar has a total population of 335 people, out of which male population is 170 while female population is 165. Literacy rate of Bhimpathar village is 74.93% out of which 82.35% males and 67.27% females are literate. There are about 74 houses in Bhimpathar village.

Dhekiajan Forest Village No 2 village is located in Margherita subdivision of Tinsukia district in Assam, India. It is situated 47km away from district headquarter Margherita. Margherita is the sub-district headquarters of Dhekiajan Forest Village No 2. The total geographical area of village is 216.71 hectares. Dhekiajan Forest Village No 2 has a total population of 282 people, out of which male population is 148 while female population is 134. Literacy rate of Dhekiajan Forest Village No 2 is 78.01% out of which 79.73% males and 76.12% females are literate. There are about 57 houses in Dhekiajan Forest Village no 2.

Kharjan village is located in Doom Dooma subdivision of Tinsukia district in Assam, India. It is situated 15km away from sub-district headquarter Doom Dooma (tehsildar office) and 36km away from district headquarter Tinsukia. Koomsung is the gram panchayat of Kharjan village. The total geographical area of village is 230.06 hectares. Kharjan has a total population of 1,259 people, out of which male population is 639 while female population is 620. Literacy rate of Kharjan village is 66.48% out of which 71.99% males and 60.81% females are literate. There are about 247 houses in Kharjan village. Doomdooma is the nearest town to Kharjan village for all major economic activities, which is approximately 15km away.

Mulong village is located in Margherita subdivision of Tinsukia district in Assam, India. It is situated 16km away from sub-district headquarter Margherita (tehsildar office) and 56km away from district headquarter Tinsukia. The total geographical area of the village is 94.29 hectares. Mulong Village has a total population of 330 people, out of which male population is 164 while female population is 166. Literacy rate of Mulong gaon is 47.58% out of which 54.88% males and 40.36% females are literate. There are about 65 houses in Mulong village.

3. List of Programmes at Adopted Villages:

The NSS Unit of Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya organized a week long special extension services programme in Dhekiajan, one of its adopted villages, from 3rd April, 2023 to 8th April, 2023. The extension services varied from environmental awareness to sensitize and create awareness among the villagers across multitude issues and concerns.

The first day of the special camp started with the inauguration of the programme by the village headman. He was accompanied by the Head teacher and the other faculties of Madhav Dev Lower Primary School, where the special camp was organized. The guest speaker for the occasion was Dr Nirza Saikia (Head Gynecologist of Civil Hospital, Digboi). The initiation day was attended by the villagers of Dhekiajan village with much interest and curiosity. On this day, 27 volunteers of our college participated in the camp.

The second day of the camp was followed on 4th April, 2023. The day began with a prayer among the attendees and was followed by the felicitation of the chief guest, Mr. Gauri Buragohain. The invited guest delivered his lecture centered around the topic of environmental awareness with the sub-theme of man-animal conflict. Gauri Buragohain spoke on the varied species and types of snakes that are common around our surroundings. His lecture also deliberated first-hand knowledge on how to recognize poisonous and non-poisonous snakes in the close vicinity of our homes and homesteads. He also imparted information on how to handle these snakes so as not to harm them and protect the species, found locally. There were generous questions from the villagers regarding this awareness programme to which the chief guest engaged and responded in a detailed manner. A total of 17 students volunteered from our college on the second day of the awareness camp.

On 5th April, 2023 the third day of the camp was kick started with the routine prayer in the school. The agenda of the special camp on this day was to impart an awareness of economic empowerment based on entrepreneurship while being based at home. With the supervision of Department of Home Science of Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya, the students of the adopted school and village were taught the basic techniques and processes of block paintings and printing on cloth. Additionally, the attendees were taught these skills by using household and discarded materials focusing on recycling and sustainability. A total of 17 volunteers participated in this event from the college.

The fourth day of the unique camp, on 6th April, 2023 began with a cleaning drive across the adopted hamlet, followed by prayer. The yoga class for the school's students, young adults, and senior village residents was the primary event. NSS volunteer Ms. Ushamoni Gogoi, a champion in yoga competition practices, led the yoga class. Thirteen volunteers took part in the initiative.

The fifth day of the camp on 7th April, 2023 did not include any major awareness or sensitization programme of extension activities. After the prayer, the volunteers cleaned the area around the school and the road leading to it because the L.P. School was closed being a Sunday. Twelve people in all volunteered for the day.

On 8th April, 2023, day 6 and the final day of the special camp started with a prayer. Dances and songs were performed by the volunteers as well as the students of the L.P. School. The day concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Smita Rani Saikia of the Department of Home Science, Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya. A total of 19 volunteers participated in the programme.

4) **Any other remarks:** In the bygone years there have been serious attempts on behalf of our college to reach out to the adopted villages. In this initiative, the NCC and NSS Units of Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya have shown exemplary leadership in cooperation with our various departments in mobilizing and organizing resource persons, volunteers and associated logistics to make our outreach programmes to successful events.

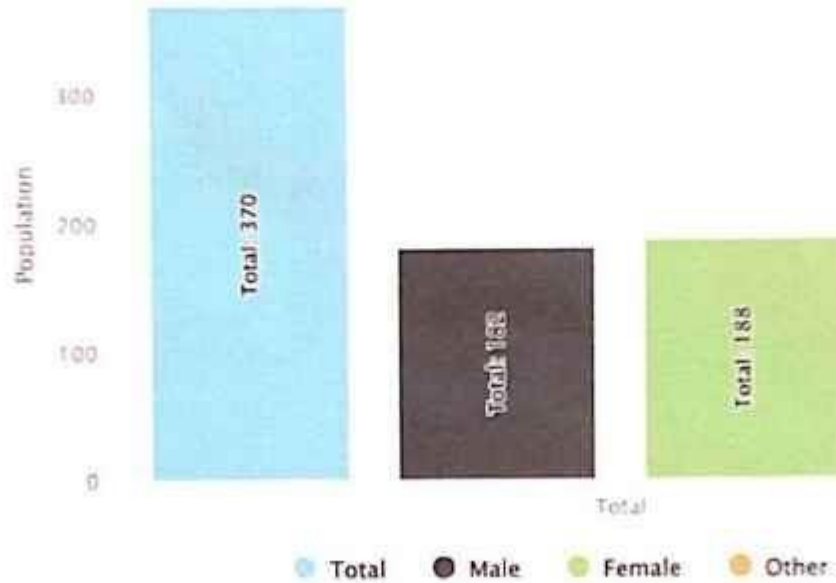
