21. Activities of IQAC during the period:

1. Student Aid Fund was created to offer financial assistance to those students belonging from Economically Weaker Section of the society. This aid fund was created under the initiative of IQAC. The implementation of the funds to the correct beneficiary was looked by the teachers unit of the college.
2. After the NAAC Peer Team visit on (09/04/18-10/04/18) and following the previous year tradition; IQAC has started once again working for the quality assurance and development of different directions of the college. In context of regular submission of AQAR, the 2018-2019 AQAR was submitted successfully on 27th September 2019.
3. 39th Foundation Day of Digboi Mahila Mahavidyalaya was observed on 5th September 2019. A lecture programme was organized in memories of Late Dwijesh Chandra Deb Sarmah by Teachers Unit and IQAC.
